

**WRIGHT TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JUNE 9, 2009**

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:40 P.M. following a Special Board Meeting at the Wright Township Office. The Pledge of Allegiance and prayer followed. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Rick Shoenborn, Linda Way and Josh Westgate.
2. No additions to the agenda.
3. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Westgate to approve the bills in the amount of \$42,239.76 and to accept the treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Schoenborn to approve the minutes of May 13 with one correction - - Library Board term runs from July 1, 2009 – July 1, 2013 instead of June. Motion carried.
4. No public comments.
5. After interviewing all the excellent candidates at the Special Meeting held at 7 p.m., a motion was made by Westgate and supported by Schoenborn to appoint Tracy Worrell to the position of Treasurer. Motion carried. We appreciate the interest in the position and hope the other candidates continue to be involved with the Township.
6. Becker discussed the problem with the hole in the sidewalk in front of Li'l Ernie's Market. Becker will contact Cheryl to determine what the next step will be.
7. Peggy O'Dea from Choice One Bank in Coopersville made a presentation as to banking services they can offer the township.
8. A motion was made by Way and supported by Westgate approve Resolution 09-06-01 - to place a renewal for North Ottawa Council on Aging on the November 3, 2009 ballot. Brigit Lewis also presented a letter indicating that the election will be underwritten by NOCCOA and no township funds will be used. Roll call vote – all ayes. Resolution declared adopted.
9. The board discussed the Wright/Tallmadge Fire Agreement and concur that no changes are necessary at this time.
10. Reports: Fire: Al Brouwer, who is doing an outstanding job, was reappointed as Fire Chief. Cemetery: Someone is dumping rubbish in Marne Cemetery. DEQ and Sheriff Department have been notified. We ask anyone to provide information leading to the apprehension of this criminal.
11. Becker updated board on the proposed county land bank authority. Appreciation to Ben Looks and son for removing a fallen tree from the rain gardens. Appreciation to

Rodney Prys for putting up the American flags around Marne. Thank you to Joel and Dan Weurding for work at the Veteran's Park and rain gardens.
The Memorial Day Parade was very nice.
